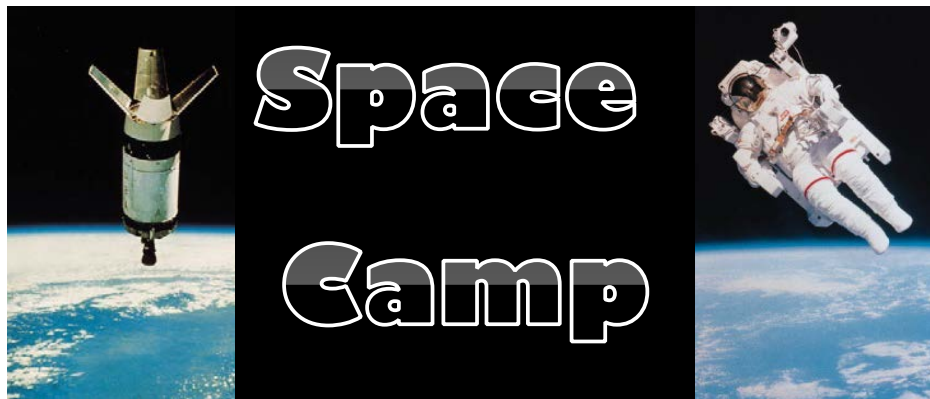

Magic Balloons – watch as these balloons magically fill with air all by themselves!

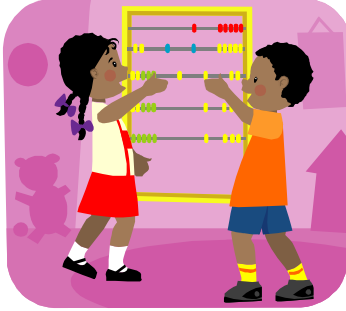
Glowing Super Slime - create gooey green slime and then watch it GLOW!
