Results of one or both tests may be required for admission to most institutions of higher learning. Students are encouraged to take entrance exams at least twice. FSA ID

The FSA ID — a username and password — has replaced the Federal Student Aid PIN and must be used to log in to certain U.S. Department of Education websites. Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs provide financial assistance to students throughout the U.S. who have significant financial need and have exhibited integrity and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity. Students may apply online by **October 25, 2017** at <https://scholars.hoatioalger.org>. Eligibility criteria is as follows:

- Enrolled full-time as a high school senior
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income required)
- Hold a minimum of 2.0 GPA
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be a U.S. citizen
