

Military Academy Admission

Senator Todd Young will be hosting Academy Day events for students interested in learning more about United States service academies: U.S. Military Academy, U.S. Naval Academy, U.S. Coast Guard Academy, U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, and U.S. Air Force Academy. Events will be August 28, 29, and 30, 2017. Please visit the guidance office for times and locations.

As a reminder, applications for nomination to a service academy are due to Senator Young's office by October 13, 2017. While attendance at an Academy Day event is not required to obtain nomination, representatives from each academy and members of the Senator's staff will be available to answer questions potential applicants may have about the academies or the congressional nominations process.

College entrance exams provide feedback on academic strengths and college preparedness to Colleges and Universities around the country. Results of one or both tests may be required for admission to most institutions of higher learning. Students are encouraged to take entrance exams at least twice.
