Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship

The Indiana Commission for Higher Education is pleased to announce the Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship application is open. The scholarship provides 200 high-achieving high school and college students interested in pursuing a career in education the opportunity to earn a renewable scholarship of up to \$7,500 each year for four academic years. In exchange, students agree to teach for five years at an eligible Indiana school.

Students interested in applying must have a teacher complete a nomination form and upload the nomination form in their online application through ScholarTrack. Applications are due by 11:59pm EST on November 30, 2017.

- **Fall 2018 application** is now open! Great news: this year we've reduced our application fee from \$50 to \$25.
- Kentucky and Southern Indiana students accepted before December 15 with 3.5 GPA and 26 ACT will be awarded **automatic scholarships** on a rolling basis.
- The Competitive **Scholarship** and **Honors Program** application is also available. To apply for either, students must first apply for admission, then apply using the Scholarship/Honors application with their same admissions application log-in.
